



An Update on Offerings in 2012


The chart opposite shows, in weekly increments from September 30, the progress toward accomplishing the level of general offerings and contributions needed in 2012 in order to meet the Budget (leaving a deficit of \$82,100) or, better still, to break-even.

Historically, offerings during the last few months of the year have contributed significantly to the financing of the ministries of the Church. Similarly generous commitments are needed again in 2012.

As of December 2, the general offerings in the year to date were 82% of the amount needed for the Church to break even for the year.


