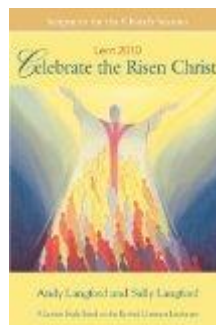

Cathie (David) and Barb are so grateful for the support and prayers of the people at YPBC.

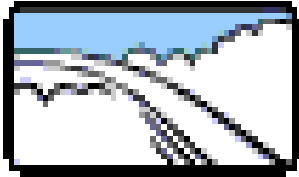

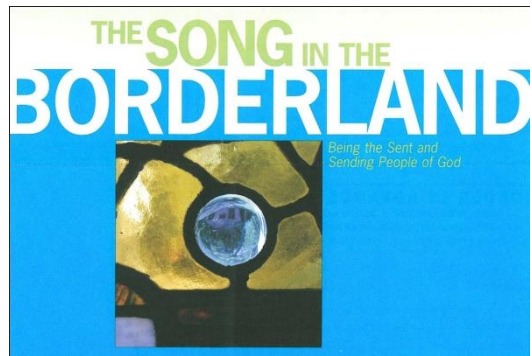
