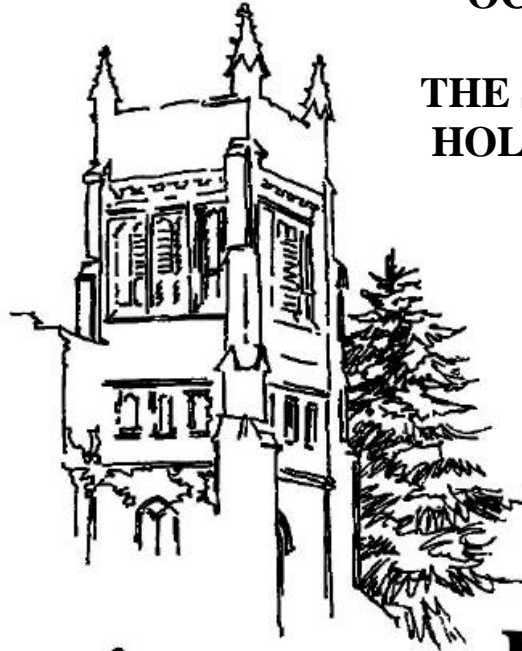

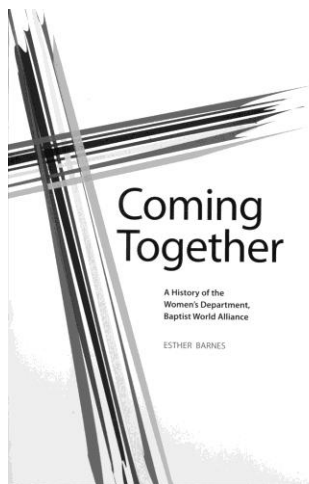

Artist reception **Sunday, October 10, 12:15-2 pm.**

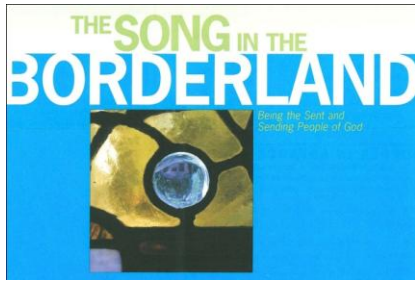
Portraits by James MacDougall OSA.
