The window was dedicated on December 10, 1991 to the glory of God and in memory of Charles P. Fell and Grace Matthew Fell.

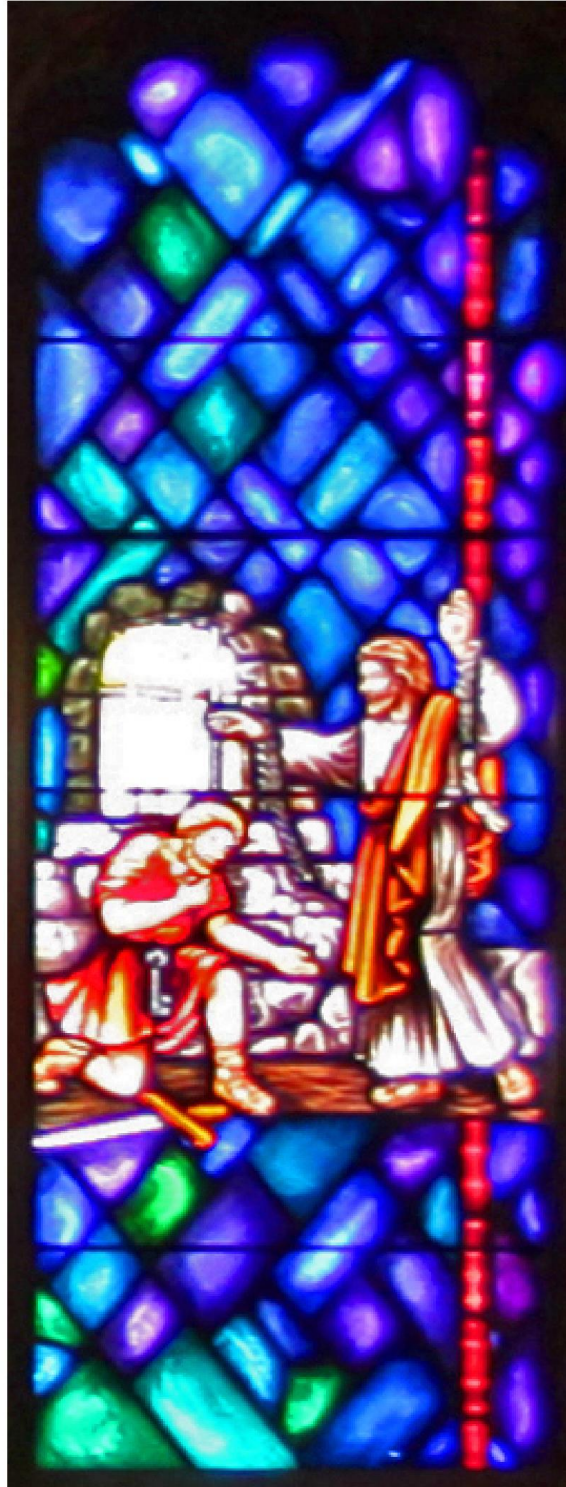
