

Paul Henderson played 18 years of professional hockey with the Detroit Red Wings, Toronto Maple Leafs, and Atlanta Flames. History will remember Paul for the 1972 Canada-USSR Series, when he scored the winning goal in each of the final three games. His winning goal in the last game is regarded as one of the greatest sports moments in the last century, and Team Canada '72 was voted the Team of the Century by the Hockey Hall of Fame. Paul is a member of several sports Hall of Fame organizations and has been honoured with numerous awards including the Order of Canada.

Paul currently works with Leader Impact where he has been developing people for leadership since 1984. He has mentored a number of men in our church through the years and we are grateful.
