It is a privilege to welcome the **Rev. Becca Stevens** to our pulpit today. Becca is with us for the next three days as one of the keynote speakers at the Lester Randall Preaching Fellowship. Becca is the Episcopalian Chaplain of Vanderbilt University as well as an author, priest, social activist and entrepreneur.

Becca is best known as the founder and president of Thistle Farms. As a survivor of abuse, and driven by a passion to promote healing and hope, Becca opened a sanctuary for survivors. Since 1997 Thistle Farms has been offering a loving community for women who have experienced trafficking, violence, and addiction. Twenty-five years later, the organization continues to welcome women; providing housing, medical care, therapy and education for two years. Residents and graduates earn income through one of three social enterprises. The Global Market of Thistle Farms helps employ more than 1,200 women worldwide, and the national network has more than 40 sister communities.

Becca has been featured in the *New York Times*, on *ABC World News* and *NPR*, and was named a 2016 *CNN Hero* and a White House *Champion of Change*. She was featured in the PBS documentary, *A Path Appears*, named Humanitarian of the Year by the Small Business Council of America and inducted into the Tennessee Women's Hall of Fame. Stevens attended the University of the South and Vanderbilt Divinity School. She has been conferred four honorary doctorates. Becca lives in Nashville with her husband, Grammy - award winning songwriter, Marcus Hummon, and their three sons. Their son, Levi, is also a rising star in the country music scene.

Today is the beginning of the **Lester Randall Preaching Fellowship**, a ministry program started in 1987 by the late Gerard H.Collins and Dr. John Gladstone and named in honour of the late Lester Randall, a leading lay person in this church.

The preaching fellowship expanded in 2013 when Metropolitan United, St. Andrew's Presbyterian, and Timothy Eaton Memorial Church all entered into a partnership with Yorkminster Park along with nine theological seminaries. Since that time, both Christ Church Deer Park and Calvin Presbyterian have become partners in the LRPF.
