**ANDRIY MARTYANOV**  
**JUNE 26, 1973 – FEBRUARY 5, 2025**

Andriy Martyanov died peacefully on February 5, 2025 after suffering a serious heart attack in late December, 2024. Andriy was 51 years of age.

Andriy leaves behind his two beloved children, Maria and Nykola, his wife and their mother, Vira, and his sister, Irina and his niece, Ekaterina.

Born in the city of Odessa, Ukraine, Andriy began sailing at the age of 18. He graduated with a Masters Degree in Maritime Navigation Engineering in 1996 from the Odessa State Maritime Academy. He served as a Master Mariner captaining crews and guiding great freighters across the oceans of the world, in and out of the great seaports, and through many storms as well as two hurricanes. Two years ago, he arrived in Canada where he has served on the maintenance team of the very busy Yorkminster Park Baptist Church. His hard work and care for the people, the sacred space and the extensive property have made a lasting impression on the community. The family are appreciative of the caring support offered by the staff at the Toronto General Hospital and by his friends at the church.
