Children who are in Grades 1 to 5 are *invited* to **Choristers**, our children's choir (Rm 203A)

10:50am

Parents/guardians sign-in their child at the YP Welcome Centre to support our **Plan2Protect** Procedures. Pagers available upon request.

11:00 to 12:15 pm

Children are a part of the service in the sanctuary with their parents at 11:00am. This provides children the experience of intergenerational worship with their church family. After the children's prayer, Preschool ages to grade 5 are lead to their Large Group Time in Cameron Hall with their leaders and helpers and then go to their Small Group Time until the end of the worship service.

Babies & Toddlers experience God's love through our caring volunteers in a warm and friendly environment. Age-appropriate toys, books, activities, music and puppets are all a part of their morning fun. Parents can bring to the nursery for 11am.

Preschool to Grade 5 explore the week's message and 'apply' what they have learned through interactive large group worship time and small group time where God's word is further unpacked with stories, age-appropriate activities, games, discussion and prayer.
